

THE LEGACY OF

JAN & CHRIS WICK



ongtime Bend residents Jan and Chris Wick were drawn to the problem of child abuse unexpectedly. Shortly after Jan joined the Bend Rotarians in 1990, club president Mike McNeil invited Jan to attend a meeting on community concerns about child abuse. Attorneys, judges, educators, child welfare investigators and law enforcement gathered to discuss how the current system was failing children and families. Victims of abuse were being retraumatized due to the number of times they had to share their story. Efforts to support families were falling short due to a lack of coordination.

This eye-opening discussion propelled Jan and several others to research how the community could better serve children.

They determined that a Children's Advocacy Center—offering both medical and therapeutic services—held the most promise.


A civil engineer, Jan took the lead on building the future KIDS Center facility with the help of his fellow rotarians, local businesses, friends and colleagues, Habitat for Humanity, and Deschutes County's community service "These past 30 years, we've given our service and support to make a difference in children's lives. program. On May 1, 1994, Jan helped cut the ribbon to officially open the community-built nonprofit.

Jan served as president of KIDS Center's board of directors from 1998-2004. In 2012, Jan and Chris threw their support behind KIDS Center's ambitious new fundraiser, Cork & Barrel. The Wick's utility, Avion Water Company, has served as the presenting sponsor for Cork & Barrel for all 11 years.

The Wicks' estate plan includes a generous bequest to KIDS Center. "When we're gone," says Jan, "the best memorial we could have would be for others to embrace our shared moral obligation to help and protect the children in our community with a gift to KIDS Center."

GET PROFESSIONAL GUIDANCE

Contact an Estate Attorney

Generally, donors with assets of \$3 Million or more seek out the assistance of an estate planner (also known as an estate planning attorney or estate probate attorney). They specialize in end-of-life planning and can walk you through the estate planning process.

Estate attorneys stay current on the laws that affect the transfer, disbursement and taxation of your estate, and can alert you if your estate plan needs to be updated accordingly.
